SUBJECT: Disc Golf course improvements at Nature Preserve

Council Meeting Agenda Item for March 25, 2019

Background Information:

The disc golf course is nearing completion. 17 of the 18 baskets have been installed, and the signs for the course are on order. Each hole will have two locations to tee from which require a concrete tee pad. Each tee pad will be approximately 5 ft wide by 10 ft long and 4 inches thick. Anderson Tree service has offered to donate the materials and labor to install these for the opportunity to put their logo on the pads. If the city were to install them, the cost to install 32 pads would be roughly \$10,680.

The area of the disc golf course has already been cleared by an archaeological survey. These tee pads should be flush with the ground allowing the mowers to mow over them rather than around. The tee pads proved a stable, even foundation for golfers to launch their discs from.

The Mineola Disc Golf club has offered to help keep the course maintained, including clearing brush from trails and weed eating around the posts, tee pads and baskets. Plans for disc golf tournaments are already in the works per Mathew Bryan who is a member of the club.

Attached to this memo is a timeline of completion for the disc golf course and a quote for the signs, which includes a map of each tee pad location.

Recommendation:

We ask that the council consider approving Anderson Tree Service to place 32 concrete tee pads, 5 ft. x 10 ft. each, two at each tee location for the disc golf course.
