
- Peak usage of the website was on Sept. 15 with just under 400 users on the site.

Eight years ago today Mineola lost one of its most valued citizens, Zeb Love. Zeb started working for the railroad in 1947. During the last 14 years of his railroad career he became known as the conductor of Amtrak's "The Love Train". He entertained his passengers, teased a bit and pampered them.






