**Background Information:** There has been discussed with fire department members and city staff concerning the city fireworks display on July 4<sup>th</sup>. Our supplier advised that he could put together a show for our budget, but he doesn't know what it will consist of. His company does not know what shipments they are going to receive. The money is budgeted but there will probably not be a fundraiser this year for reimbursement. I will have to submit the permit application to TDI as soon as possible to make sure it gets processed in time and place the order for fireworks. I have submitted a request to the governor's office for any information on this but I'm not sure when we will get an answer.
