Mineola High School Class of 2020 Graduation Guidelines

Location: Meredith Memorial Stadium

Time and Date: Friday, June 5th at 8:00 p.m..

Alternate Date: Saturday, June 6th at 8:00 p.m..

Virtual Graduation Date: Filmed on Tuesday, May 19th and Released on Saturday, June 6th at 8:00 p.m.. if Live Graduation is cancelled.

Guidelines and Procedures

Each student will be given 5 wristbands for guest access to the ceremony. These wristbands must be worn at the point of entrance into the stadium.

Each student will be given 2 parking tags for entrance into the parking area. These tags will need to be displayed on the rear view mirror of any vehicle accessing the parking lot area.

Students will arrive at 7:00 p.m. and enter the north parking lot of Meredith Memorial Stadium. All students will come fully dressed and ready to participate in the ceremony. Staff members will assist them in lining up to participate in the ceremony following proper social distancing guidelines. Each student will be required to submit a Health Screening Survey prior to participation in the ceremony.

Gates will open at 7:00 p.m.. Each entrant will be required to have a wristband and Health Screening Survey completed and in hand prior to entering Meredith Memorial Stadium. Restrooms will be available to the public for emergency situations. These will be monitored to

limit one person in and one person out. Custodial staff will clean faucets and door handles briefly after each individual use.

Law enforcement officials will check vehicle tags upon entry to stadium parking and check wristbands at the entrance for stadium seating.

Following the ceremony, students will be escorted to their vehicles by school employees to leave the facility. Once all students have started exiting the stadium, guests will be released in an orderly fashion. There will be no gathering in the parking lot following the ceremony.

- These guidelines will be reviewed with the Mineola Chief of Police, Mineola ISD Chief of Police, Mayor of Mineola, and Wood County Judge before release to the public.
- Detailed letters will be mailed to all students participating in the Graduation Ceremony. These guidelines will also be made available to the public prior to the Ceremony.
- Health Screening Surveys can be downloaded online 3 days prior to the event.
