

ETCOG splits \$1M in coronavirus funding between East Texas

TYLER, Texas (KLTV) - The East Texas Council of Governments (ETCOG) announces \$1 million in grants from the Office of the Governor's (OOG) Criminal Justice Division awarded to East Texas jurisdictions to address the public safety challenges posed by the outbreak of COVID-19. These funds come from the Coronavirus Emergency Supplemental Funding (CESF) Program authorized by the federal Emergency Appropriations for Coronavirus Health Response and Agency Operations Act.

ETCOG's Public Safety Division assisted local jurisdictions in applying for these funds after Governor Greg Abbott announced in July 2020 that \$41 million had been made available for


cities and counties in Texas.

Local units of governments may use funds awarded under the CESF Program for first responder overtime and hazard pay; equipment and supplies supporting teleworking technologies, social distancing, and personal protective gear; county jail costs associated with the medical needs of inmates as well as reimbursement for holding inmates awaiting transfer to the Texas Department of Criminal Justice.

ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MINEOLA, TEXAS AMENDING THE 2021 BUDGET EXPENDITURES FOR FISCAL YEAR ENDING SEPTEMBER 30, 2021; AUTHORIZING EXPENDITURES AS SET OUT IN SUCH BUDGET AMENDMENT AND PROVIDING FOR EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Mineola, Texas, adopted Ordinance No. 20-09-14-01 on September 14, 2020, approving expenditures for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2021 pursuant to the laws of the State of Texas; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to amend the 2021 budget.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MINEOLA, TEXAS:

Section 1. The appropriation amounts of the official budget of the City of Mineola for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2021 are hereby amended as described below:

Section 2. To provide for expenditures under the Coronavirus Emergency Supplemental Fund (CESF) Program Grant, approved by Council Resolution 20-06-22-3 and awarded on 7/1/2020.

Section 3. To provide for installing Peacemaker software and Antimicrobial tablets and docking stations for police vehicles and additional operating and sanitization supplies.

Section 4. The amendments to authorized appropriations for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2021, are summarized as follows:

Section 5. The City Manager is hereby authorized to make intra-departmental and interdepartmental fund transfers within a fund during the fiscal year as becomes necessary in order to avoid the over-expenditure of a particular object code or department.

Section 6. A true and correct copy of the Amended Budget is hereby directed to be filed in the office of the City Secretary, and said Amended Budget is made part of this Ordinance by reference as though fully copied herein verbatim.

Section 7. It is being deemed by the City Council that this Ordinance shall go into immediate effect and force after its passage, approval and publication according to law.
