### **Background Information:**

Jim and Jeanne Hinderman local members of the Texas Equestrian Trail Riders Association, requested that the Mineola Parks and Open Spaces consider allowing their group (TETRA) to name an existing trail at back part of the preserve that currently remains unnamed, the Kacey Musgraves Trail. TETRA would like to name it the Kacey Musgraves trail to honor Ms. Musgraves who is also a horse enthusiast and loves horse riding who advocates for equestrian activities.

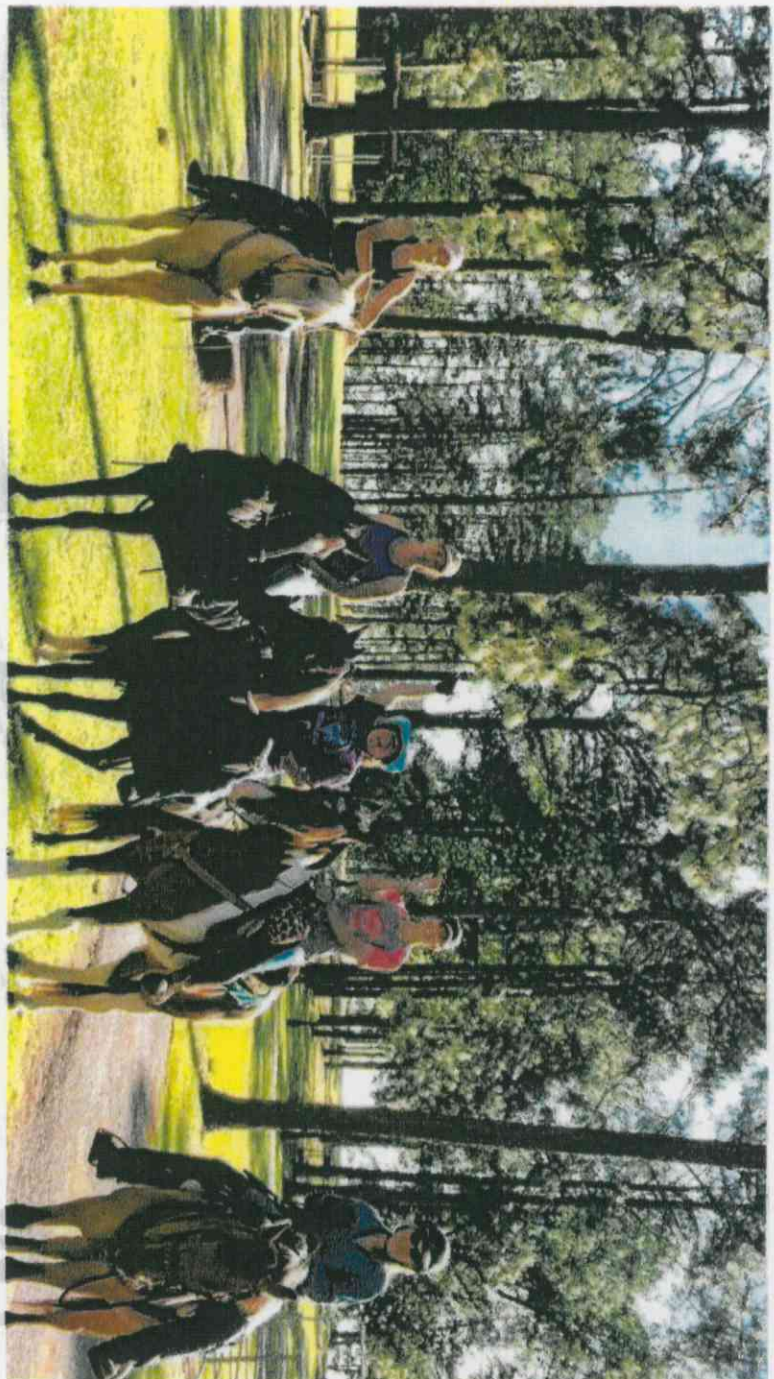
At the Parks board meeting, Wednesday March 17, 2021 the Parks & Open Spaces voted to allow TETRA to name the last remaining Equestrian Trail at the Preserve, the Kacey Musgraves Trail. TETRA will have the signs made and installed at the Nature Preserve if approved by Mayor and City Council.
