SUBJECT: Water, Wastewater and Multi-Meter fee increases

Background Information:

These following ordinances are to increase utility service fees by 3%. The last rate increase was on September 23, 2019 for the 2019-2020 Fiscal Year. These increases are reflected in the FY 2021-2022 budget and are needed to maintain operations and growth.

Recommendation:

It is recommended that the council approve the ordinances.

Final Disposition:

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 44-29 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF MINEOLA, TEXAS, PROVIDING FOR RATES TO BE CHARGED FOR SERVICES FURNISHED BY THE WATERWORKS OWNED AND OPERATED BY THE CITY OF MINEOLA, TEXAS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MINEOLA, TEXAS, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 44-29 of the Code of Ordinances, City of Mineola, Texas, is hereby amended to read as follows, to-wit:

Section 44-29. Service rates –Generally

The following rates shall be charged by the City to users of water provided by the City of Mineola:

Water Service (3/4" x 5/8" Meter Size)		
Service Type	Monthly Minimum (no usage)	Per 100 Gal
Residential Inside City	\$13.95	\$ 0.7793
Residential Outside City	\$14.74	\$ 0.8971
Commercial Inside City	\$31.58	\$ 0.7793
Commercial Outside City	\$36.26	\$ 0.8971

The rates shall be effective for the October, 2021 billing period.
