4.	A sound system to distribute music in downtown. Merchants have requested music be played on our streets and currently the music is playing from one speaker that remains from a system installed when the sidewalks were restored in 2000. The system we are requesting will be better technology and will use five speaker units to be able to transmit to a larger area of our downtown not limited to Broad Street as it is today. This system will also be used for announcing events from the Gazebo area and Chamber area as needed by the City during events and as an emergency system to let our merchants know if there is important message we need to pass on to the public.  Request for the system and installations with mobile transmitter is \$14,050.00
5.	Landmark Commission Request to fund and continue to work on further phases of Iron Horse Square development. Currently phase VIII and phase XII for the Iron Horse Square Project are for the Historical Walking Trail with Interactive Signage and Intermittent Shade Coverings. Education is a big part of our mission and with this trail we will be able to tell the story of Mineola for many years to come. If we are to continue to work on rebuilding and repairing streets, we need to have a machine that is dependable and that we know we can easily get parts for if needed. We have gone online to the Buy Board, (we are a member) which is a company who bids out all supplies and equipment for government needs to find the best price and equipment to purchase.
