### **Background Information:**

Music in May is a joint venture between the City of Mineola’s marketing and tourism department and Mineola Main Street. The event consists of 4 Thursday evenings in May (May 5, 12, 19, and 26) where we will have live music in the Gazebo area. Citizens bring their own chairs and refreshments and enjoy the music from 6:30-8:30. The event will be sponsored by local businesses and the City of Mineola.

### **Recommendation:**

My recommendation is for the council to consider a street closure for the evenings of May 5, 12, 19, and 26 for the event from 5:00-9:30 p.m. The closure would be on West Commerce Street between the Johnson Street and the Veterans Memorial. South Johnson from the alley to the Gazebo and East Commerce at the Gazebo. Parking for the event will still be available in the parking lot on Line Street and on East Commerce and West Commerce near the Line restaurant. Minimal storefronts affected since those that would be affected close their doors at 5:00.

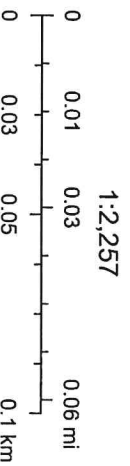
