## **Background Information:**

Due to active attacks in public places, more especially regarding the recent events that took place during the active attack at Rob Elementary School in Uvalde Texas, the Governor's Office is releasing grant funding to supply ballistic shields to all Law Enforcement agencies in the State of Texas. This grant will be 100% funded and involves zero matching from the City of Mineola.

## Recommendation:

Due to the uncertainty of these type events, the police department would like to ask for 10 ballistic shields with a total value of \$64,000.00. Currently the police department has two ballistic shields that are over 20 years old and are needing replacement.

Ballistic Shields are very costly and if approved for this grant it will allow us to have new ballistic shields in 10 of our mobile patrol units and available at all times. As we know it is never known when and where an active attack could occur. Placing shields in our patrol units will allow them to be available if needed at any time and place we respond. The shield will aid in creating a safer environment for our officers as well as providing a more timely response to those situations. I recommend that the Mayor and City Council take this into consideration and approve the resolution to accept grant funding for these shields.
