ORDINANCE _____

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 34-22 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF MINEOLA, TEXAS,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MINEOLA, TEXAS, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 34-22 of the Code of Ordinances, City of Mineola, Texas, is hereby amended to read as follows, to-wit:

Section 34-22. Service rates - Schedule

(a) The rates for commercial containerized (dumpster service) for solid waste collection inside and outside the city limits shall be as follows:
